Farm Dog Geese Course Description

 Gather 10 head of geese from end of goose arena. Bring up to repen via the left side of free-standing pen. When geese have passed back plane of pen gather is complete.

Gather 20 points

- 2. Move the geese from repen area around right side of oak tree to graze area on right back area of the arena. This is marked by cones.

 Pasture work 20 points
- Hold all 10 head of geese in area designated by cones for 1 minute.

 Hold 10 points
- 4. Move geese from hold area into take-out pen.

Pen 10 points

- 5. In take-out pen sort the 5 Africans from the 5 Buffs, using the back small gate. Move the Africans through gate into back.
 Keep Buffs in pen.
 Sort 25 points
- 6. Move the Buffs from the take-out pen into the chute pen on the left.

 Pen 10 points
- 7. Move the Buffs into Chute and dust them and return them into duck arena.

 Chute 20 points
- 8. Move the Buffs from arena into Re-pen. Pen 5 points
- 9. In Re-pen move all 5 Buffs into large wire kennel positioned at back of pen.

 Load 10 points

Time allotted for course will be 10 minutes. A 7 minute warning and a 3 minute warning will be given. Time starts when dog is sent to pick up geese and stops when last goose is in crate. All geese must be in crate for that part to count. Ties will be broken by time. If tie still exsts then gather points will be used to break tie.

Snowy Butte ASC Farm Dog Cattle Course Description

1. Gather 5 head of cattle from set-out. Cattle will be set on hay and held by people on horseback. When dog is sent riders will disengage. *Advanced handler must remain 150 feet from cattle for gather, Open handler may go half-way Gather: 20 points 2. Move cattle once they have passed the handlers line to barn corral. Drive or fetch, handler's choice. Pasture work: 20 points 3. Pen cattle in barn corral. Close gate. Pen: 5 points 4. Move all 6 head into round pen. *Advanced handler must remain at round pen gate. Pen: 10 points Sort designated 3 head back into barn corral. Sort: 25 points 6. Move the 3 in barn corral through squeeze chute. While cow is in chute, dust for fly control. Chute: 10 points 7. Leave those 3 cows in corral and get remaining 3 from round

pen and put with first 3.

9. Load the 6 in take-out pen into trailer.

Time allotted for course will be 30 minutes. A 10 minute and a 3 minute warning will be given. Time starts when dog is sent and stops when last head of cattle is in trailer. Ties will be broken by time. If a tie still exists gather points will be used.

8. Take all 6 head and move into and thru alley into take-out pen.

Pen: 10 points

Chute: 10 points

Load: 20 points

Snowy Butte ASC Mixed Farm Dog Trial-

Course Description

Cattle Part 1

- 1. Gather 5 head of cattle set on hay. Cattle will be held by 2 riders on horseback. Open Handlers may place dog on or behind Handler's line which will be a minimum of 150 feet from stock. Handler may go ½ way between cattle and cone before sending their dog. *Advanced handlers send dog from advanced handler's line-150 feet- or any place of their choosing behind designated line. (Gather--10 points)
- 2. Drive or Fetch cattle from gather line into barn corral

(pasture work 10 points)

3. Pen all 5 head in corral and close gate.

(pen 3 points)

- Move all 5 head of cattle into round pen and close gate. *Advanced handlers must remain at gate while open handlers may
 assist dog. (Pen-3 points)
- 5. Sort 3 head from the 5 and move 3 into corral with squeeze chute. *Open any 3, Advanced those 3 specified by judge.

(sort 12 points)

6. Put the 3 head of cattle through squeeze chute and administer shots.

(chute 10 points)

- 7. The 2 head remaining in the round pen will then be moved back into the barn corral with the sorted 3.
- (Pen--3 points)

8. All 5 head will be moved from the barn corral, thru the alley into the take-out pen.

(pen 4 points)

 Load all 5 head of cattle into stock trailer parked at side of take-out pen. Handler to move directly to sheep gather once load is complete. (load-10 points)

(Time will be stopped while handler and dog proceed to position for gather of sheep and goats. Time restarted when dog begins gather.

Sheep and Goats Part 2

- Gather 10 head of stock (5 sheep + 5 goats) set on hay and held by set-out dog and handler. Handler's line will be clearly marked. Open handler may set dog at handler's line-150 feet from stock and proceed half-way before sending dog.
 *Advanced Handler and dog must remain behind designated 150 foot line for the gather. Open may set dog at designated line and handler may proceed half-way before sending dog. (gather 10 points.)
- 2. Bring animals from gather line to barn corral. Drive or Fetch, handler's choice.

(pasture work 10 points)

3. Pen all 10 head in corral.

(pen 3 points)

4. Move all 10 head into round pen and close gate.

(pen 4 points)

5. Sort the 5 goats from the sheep using the gate between round pen and small pen. Goats in round pen and sheep in small pen. May sort in either direction. Open handlers may assist. *Advanced handlers remain at gate during this exercise.

(sort 13 points)

- 6. Move the 5 sheep through chute and administer shot to each sheep. Put into left pen at end of squeeze chute. (chute 5 points)
- 7. Move goats into small pen and load them in front of trailer. Close center door.

(load 5 points)

8. Move the 5 sheep from left pen through chute into small pen.

(chute 5 points)

9. Close guillotine gate when all 5 sheep are in small pen.

(pen 5 points)

10. Load all 5 sheep into back of stock trailer. Time stops when all 5 are in trailer.

(Load 5 points)

Time to complete course is 20 minutes. Time stops when all animals are in trailer. A ten minute and a three minute warning will be given. Ties will be broken by gather points. If tie still exists elapsed course time will be used. *Denotes Advanced Handler

Snowy Butte ASC Farm Dog Sheep

Course Description

- 1. *Gather 10 head of sheep (5 ewes + 5 collared lambs. Handler's line will be marked. Sheep will be set on hay and held by set-out dog with handler. Set-out dog will be called off when competitor's dog is sent. *Advanced Handlers and their dog will send from marked line or any place behind it.. Open dog to be set on line at 150 feet and handler may go ½ distance between sheep and line. Gather ends at advanced handler's line. (Gather—20 points)
- 2. Move all 10 head from advanced handler's line to barn corral. (pasture work 10 points)
- 3. Pen all 10 head in barn corral. (pen 5 points)
- 4. *Move all 10 head from corral into round pen. Adv Handler's must remain at gate. (pen 5)
- 5. Using gate between small pen and round pen sort the 5 ewes from the 5 collared lambs. Ewes remain in round pen. May sort from small to round pen or vice versa. Handler's choice
 *Advanced handlers are to remain at gate to complete the sort. Open handlers may assist dogs if they so choose.
 (Sort—25 points)
- 6. Move the 5 collared sheep through chute and footbath. (footbath 10)
- 7. Move collared sheep into left pen from chute. (pen 5)
- 8. Move 5 collared sheep into small pen through chute. (chute 20)
- 9. Load all collared sheep into front of trailer and close dividing gate. (Load—10 points)
- 10. *Move 5 sheep in round pen into small pen. Advanced Handler must remain at gate. (Pen 10)
- 11. Load the 5 sheep into back of trailer. Time stops when last ewe is in trailer. (Load—10 points)

_Time stops when all 10 head are in trailer. Time allowed to complete course is 20 minutes. A 10 minute and a 3 minute warning will be given. All ties will be broken by time. If a tie still exists then gather points will be used. *denotes advanced handler from open handler tasks
